Former addresses for CBC in K.C. are: P.O. Box 8426 until June 1, 1966 & 1111 West 39<sup>th</sup> Street until August 15, 1980. Citadel Bible College, from Ozark, Arkansas, founded in 1946, merged with Calvary Bible College on July 21, 1987. In 1966, the Graduate Division of Calvary Bible College was established. In 1986, it was expanded to become Calvary Graduate School of Theology. In 1992, the name was changed to Calvary Theological Seminary. IN 2016, Calvary Bible College & Theological Seminary became known as Calvary University.
